
Course Overview

In order to master the skills above I will be using a variety of teaching strategies including...


- ★ In-class lecture and note taking


Class books will be provided and kept in the classroom. Access to online books will be TBA.

Rules


1. You are expected to be **on time** for class with your needed **materials** to **every** class. You should **never** come to class without them.
2. You are expected to schedule an **extra help** session with me if you feel like you are not working up to your potential in class.
3. You are expected to complete **all** assigned work and make up **any** work missed due to absence. If you miss a day it is **your** responsibility to get the work you missed from a fellow student or to come ask me what you missed. If a lab or test was missed arrangements will be made to make it up at a later time.
4. You are expected to make your work **original**. Any scholastic dishonesty, or "cheating" will result in a **zero** for the assignment. This includes looking at notes or another student's paper during a test or quiz, copying another student's homework, plagiarizing from any source without properly notating, or providing information about test and/or quizzes.

Labs/Projects

Students will be assigned labs and projects each term. They will pertain to what we are learning at that time. Students will be given detailed instructions as well as a grading rubric at the beginning of each lab/project.

Quizzes

Quizzes will be given at the discretion of teacher in the form of formative and summative assessments, to provide feedback to the teacher to assess student mastery.
